Please make sure all parts of the application are complete and that all attachments are included. **Attachment pages** are for Parts 3 **Proof of acceptance**/attendance, and and Part 5 **the Essay**.

Delivery of the application package can be done in one of three ways.

- 1. Use a flat-bed scanner (not a camera) to transform your application to PDF file format, and then **email** it by **April 28, 2025** to: naacp.barth3071@gmail.com
- 2. Personally deliver your application to the NAACP office by April 28, 2025
- 3. Mail your application to the NAACP office, postmarked no later than April 19, 2025.
